

The September 21st meeting of the vestry encompassed updates on items progressing **AS PLANNED**, such as a financial report indicating that Trinity is in good stead and anticipates ending the year within budget, as well as the opening of a new cycle of opportunities for Christian formation for those of all ages and stages. The annual stewardship campaign will occur as planned and will be strengthened and improved by several new elements.

CHANGES underway were discussed, including a suggestion that listening sessions for the congregation be held to process the announcement that Father Jon is one of the candidates under consideration for bishop in the Springfield, Illinois diocese. The resignation of Junior Warden Willie Meadows, another challenging change, will be handled by a plan to provide substitute coverage through delegation of duties for routine tasks and projects under a certain expenditure threshold to staff. Unanticipated larger issues will be addressed by calling into action the building and grounds committee and those they delegate. A candidate for Junior Warden will be presented as part of the regularly scheduled elections during annual meeting in January.

The vestry voted to take several **OFFICIAL ACTIONS**, each important in their own way:

1. To affirm the call to ordination to Reverend Aaron Rogers as a priest in the Episcopal Church.
2. To amend the charter for the newly formed parish engagement committee.
3. To initiate purchase of new pew cushions within existing budget.
